## **NOTIFICATION OF A PERSONAL DATA BREACH**

Dear Sir/Madam,

MDM NT sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Bielsko-Biała (hereinafter: the “**Controller**”), acting pursuant to Article 34 of the GDPR, hereby informs you of a cybersecurity incident of 16 December 2025, which may have resulted in unauthorised access to certain personal data processed in the Controller’s systems.

### **Nature of the personal data breach**

On 16 December 2025, the Controller detected an incident involving unauthorised access to part of the IT environment and the deployment of ransomware, which caused the unavailability of certain systems. A forensic investigation is underway to determine the course of events and the scope of potential access to data. At this stage, we have no confirmation that the data has been made public; however, due to the nature of the attack, it cannot be ruled out that an unauthorised person gained access to personal data processed in the systems affected by the incident.

The incident may have concerned the data of contact persons on the side of clients/contractors, in particular: first and last name, business contact details, company name, position/function, and data relating to the business relationship. The scope of data may vary depending on the relationship and the history of cooperation.

### **Description of the possible consequences of the personal data breach**

Potential consequences may primarily include: impersonation attempts (phishing), attempts at fraud or inducing specific actions (e.g. clicking a link or opening an attachment), as well as attempted scams related to settlements (e.g. fraudulent requests to change a bank account number or invoicing details).

### **Description of measures taken by the Controller to minimise potential effects**

After detecting the incident, the Controller immediately took measures to limit its effects, with the involvement of external specialists, including isolating the affected resources, securing available logs and evidence, and conducting a forensic investigation. The Controller has made (or is promptly making) the required notifications to the competent entities, including CERT Poland and—through the appropriate channels—the

President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO) and law enforcement authorities.

### **Description of measures recommended to you to minimise potential negative consequences**

We recommend in particular:

- exercising caution with unusual messages/emails/phone calls, especially those containing links, QR codes or attachments,
- verifying requests to provide information or make payments—by calling back or replying using a known, previously used telephone number/email address,
- exercising particular caution with requests to change a bank account number or settlement/billing details (verification via another channel).
